(i) ABOUT TICKETS

YOU MUST HAVE A VALID LUAS TICKET TO TRAVEL ON LUAS.

Buy tickets from Luas ticket machines or a Leap Card from Leap Card agents.

Persons without a valid ticket will receive a Standard Fare of €45 from Luas Revenue Protection Officers. Failure to pay a Standard Fare can result in a court conviction and a fine of €1,000.

All passengers with Adult 30 Day tickets are required to carry Luas or Dublin Bus ID; available free of charge, see www.luas.ie for details.

Luas Child Tickets and Leap Card Child Tickets valid for 4yrs to 15yrs inclusive. Personalised Leap Card Child Fares apply 16yrs to 18yrs inclusive. Children under 4yrs travel free. Proof of age may be required.

When travelling to a Stop on the boundary of two zones you do not pay for the zone you are entering.

Luas ticket machines accept debit/credit cards. The minimum transaction is $\varepsilon 5. \ \,$






